



Training Objectives The training covers perinatal mental health assessment, screening, symptoms, treatment options, family concerns, fathers, social support, and referral systems.




Dr. Kristy Christopher-Holloway Therapist | Educator






The Power of Perinatal Mental Health Training

50%

Perinatal mental health is gaining more attention as a critical issue within maternal health with severe racial and health equity concerns.

Almost 50% of Black mothers will experience maternal mental health (MMH) conditions, according to the Maternal Mental Health Leadership Alliance.

Compared to white women, Black women are twice as likely to experience MMH conditions but half as likely to receive care.

PSI has developed an internationally recognized, unique, and evidence-based training program for health providers and social support networks to address perinatal mood & anxiety disorders. It is critical that this program be supported in order to increase the number of providers available to offer culturally competent mental health care during and after pregnancy.


